Group projects run from April to June, and September to November. Typically held on Thursdays, 1pm to 4pm.

Volunteer Activities

Depending on the season and need, projects might include raking, mulching, weeding, bulb planting, tree care, garden bed maintenance, farm projects, and more. Participants must be able to bend and lift items that weigh 10 pounds. Dress for the weather and plan to get your hands and clothes dirty!

Corporate Engagement Fee

We ask all of our corporate and for-profit volunteer groups to assist the Garden through a corporate engagement fee made in advance of their volunteer day. We are deeply grateful for the work of our volunteer groups, and this fee helps cover the costs of planning and executing our volunteer events.

Work gloves, tools, snack bars and water are provided to volunteers.

- Groups of up to 15 people are asked for a fee of \$1,000
- Groups of up to 30 people are asked for a fee of \$1,750 (Note: groups may be divided into 2 activities)
