

CORPORATE VOLUNTEER ACTIVITIES 2019

Date Options: Thursdays in April, May, June, October and November.
9am to 12pm and 1pm to 4pm sessions

Horticulture: Your group will be led by a QBG Horticulture expert in a hands-on seasonal work activity. Depending on season and need, projects might include: raking, mulching, weeding, planting bulbs, perennial cutback and more. Participants must be able to bend and lift items that weigh 10 pounds or more. Dress for the weather and plan to get your hands dirty! Work gloves, tools, and water will be provided.

\$1,000 for approximately 20 people

Farm & Compost: Your group will be led by NYC Compost Project staff in tasks such as planting, weeding, harvesting, and garden bed preparation in our Farm. Participants must be able to bend and lift items that weigh 10 pounds. Dress for the weather and plan to get your hands dirty! Work gloves, tools, and water will be provided.

\$1,000 for approximately 20 people

Catering options: Enjoy an al-fresco meal on our Terrace in the heart of our Garden to fortify yourself for, or replenish after, your volunteer experience.

Breakfast: Includes coffee and tea, juice, bagels, baked goods, fresh fruit platter. *\$15 per person*

Lunch: Includes starters and salads, main course (sandwiches or finger foods), dessert, and soft drinks. Menus to be provided. *\$30 per person*

Happy Hour: Mingle on the Green Roof overlooking the Garden to celebrate the fruits of your labor. Includes beer, wine, botanical mocktail, and various appetizers. *\$30 per person/hour*

Photography Add-On:

We offer professional photography to capture your team's service or social experience. Includes a digital gallery with downloadable high-resolution images and social media shout-outs on QBG platforms. *\$250 per session or \$450 for the day*
